They've had a thunderstorm but other than that the weather has been hot, hot, hot!

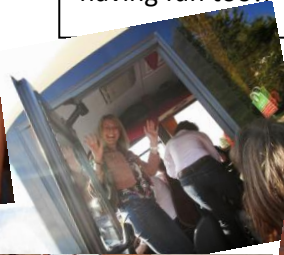
