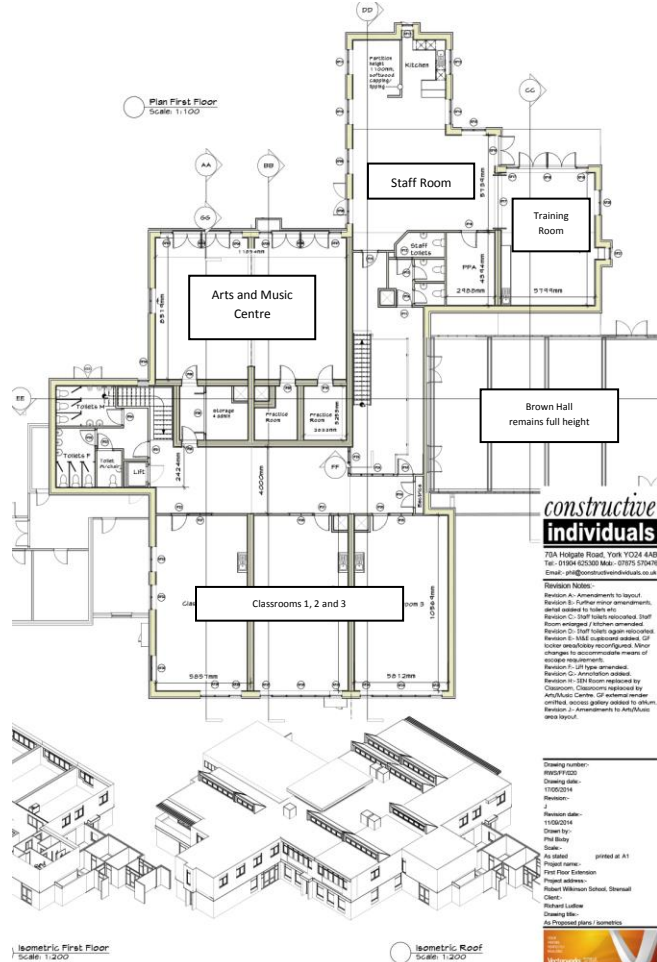

The current plan for our new extension has just been released. Due to finance constraints we have joined two projects together to create an exciting extension, adding considerably to our school facilities and the opportunities we will be able to provide for your children and the future pupils of our school. 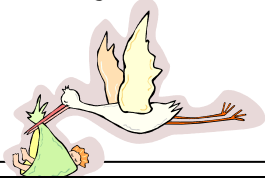
